949 Hilton Parma Corners Road

Property merge

Kris Schultz presented to the Board a plan which proposes to merge 945, 959, 961 and 949 Hilton Parma Corners Road into one property. All parcels are owed by Joe Scortino.

Mr. Schultz stated that two of the properties have homes on them and that one of the homes will need to be removed prior to the properties being merged. Mr. Schultz stated that the owner is in the process right now of getting all of the properties re-zoned and does not want to have to remove one of the homes until he knows that the re-z0ning has been granted.

After a small discussion there the Board stated that they agreed with the proposed plans and stated if the applicant is successful in getting the property re-zoned the Board would issue a motion to approve the merger of the properties, as long as one of the homes had been removed.
